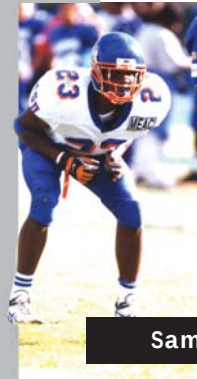

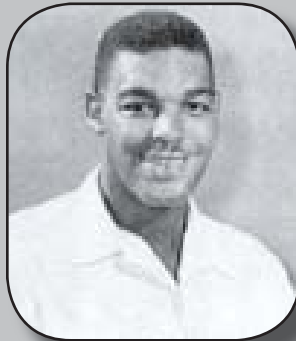

New York Giant and All-Pro Lineman **Roosevelt Brown** was inducted into the NFL 'Hall of Fame' in 1975



Len Ford - began his career as a two-way end in the old AAFC with Cleveland and caught 67 passes in two years, then turned solely to defense and was a pass-rushing demon



Leroy Kelly was named All-NFL five times and was named to six Pro Bowls... Kelly started his career as a punt and kick returner until he took over for Jim Brown when Brown retired after the 1965 season



Willie Lanier - Kansas City Chiefs starting middle linebacker for 11 years... helped Chiefs to Super Bowl IV victory over the Minnesota Vikings

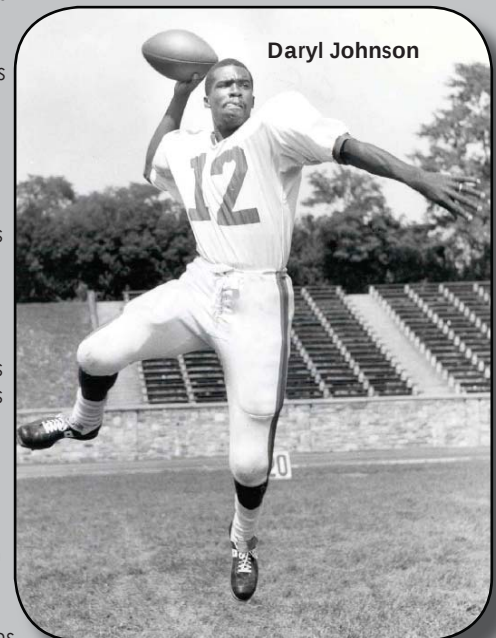

Jon Voroshilin

1 - Worn by All-MEAC kicker/punter **Jon Voroshilin**, who had an outstanding collegiate career. Set a record with the longest punt in MSU history when he booted a 72-yarder against Bethune-Cookman (10/4/04).

6 - Worn by All-MEAC tailback **Ali Culpepper**, who had an outstanding collegiate career as he racked up 2,727 yards (1998-2001).

8 - Worn by All-MEAC tailback **T.J. Stallings**, who set a MSU record by scoring 5 touchdowns against Howard University and holds the school's single season rushing record with 1,169 yards (2002).

13 - **Steve Turpin** played wide receiver, quarterback and defensive back while at MSU.

He holds the school record averaging 45 yards per punt in 1974...He also had 10 career interceptions, 12 caught passes in a single game, 500 passing yards, and 5 touchdowns.

15 - Worn by **Robert Wade** who converted from QB to be a star DB. Wade was an All-American and All-CIAA performer. He was drafted by the Baltimore Colts where he finished second in the 1968 Defensive Rookie of the Year. Wade also played for the Pittsburgh Steelers, Washington Redskins, and Denver Broncos.

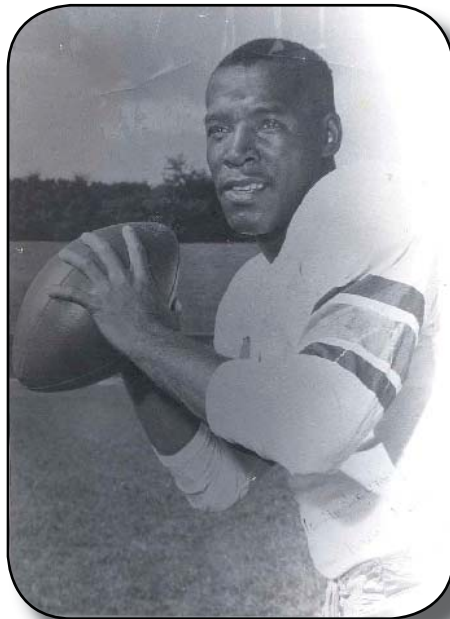
17 - Worn by **Allen Rose**, who was an outstanding quarterback and remains as one of Morgan State's All-Time passers by throwing for 2,488 yards (1975-78). Rose also holds the record for most punting yardage (3,215) and attempts (79).

18 - Worn by **Clarence Holzendorf**, who was an outstanding wide receiver and remains as one of Morgan State's All-Time receivers by averaging 24.7 yards per reception and 2,337 yards (1979-80).

19/69 - Worn by **Jack Dennis**, who was known throughout the conference as "Dennis the Menace" was drafted by the Green Bay Packers and Montreal Alouettes.

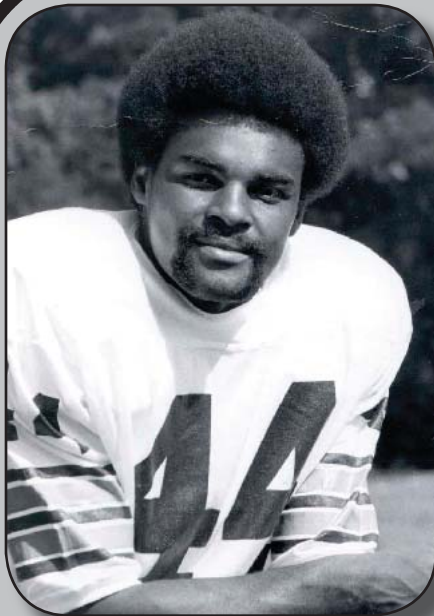

24 - Worn by **Oliver Dobbins**, who was a Bear running back. Dobbins was drafted by the Buffalo Bills and had his career cut short due to injury. Dobbins shared the backfield with Bear great Leroy Kelly.

31 - Worn by **Leroy Kelly**, who was named All-NFL five times, was named to six NFL Pro Bowls, was inducted into the NFL Hall of Fame. Known as the man who replaced Jim Brown.

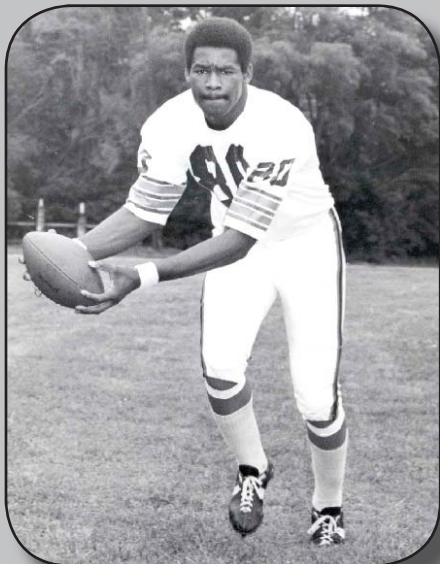
35/69 - Worn by **Jack Rozier**, who played right end

and tight end for the 1956 team, All-conference in football and basketball and was also a three-star general in the army.

37 - Worn by **Joe Fowlkes**, Morgan State's defensive back holds the school's career interception record with 15 and was a two-star All-American and was the only African-American to grace the cover of the NCAA Lacrosse Guide.

40 - Worn by **Mike Collier**, who was an excellent return man. Collier ran a 4.5 forty and had great break-away speed. He had 55, 56, 86, and 92 yard returned kicks for touchdowns.

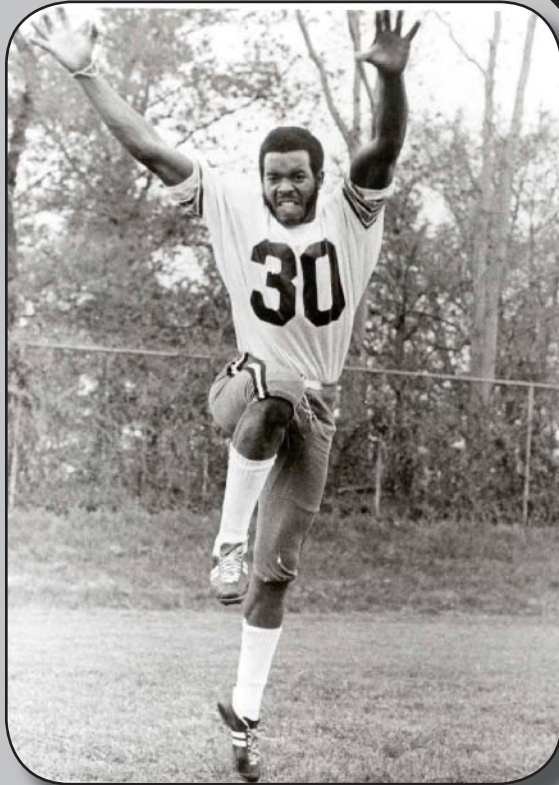
41 - **George Nock** led the Bears rushing attack during its 33 straight win streak and played for Washington Redskins and the Baltimore Colts.

42 - Worn by **Bobby Hammond**, who was small in stature but durable and a serious running threat. Set MSU record in single game rushing yards when he scored 2 touchdowns and gained 201 yards vs. N.C. A&T in 1973.

44 - Worn by **John Sykes**, who was an All-American at halfback on the 1969 Morgan State team, he averaged 4 yards per carry...Was hailed as the next Leroy Kelly.

47 - Worn by **Gerald Huggins**, who was runner-up to the MEAC most Valuable Player Award, yet didn't make the First-Team All-MEAC Conference Team...He helped lead the '79 team to the MEAC Championship.

48 - Worn **Tim Baylor**, who was a defensive back. As a freshman he had 19 pass deflections and 49 tackles of which 20 of those tackles were solo tackles.

49 - Worn by **Eugene "Superman" Simms**, who was outstanding as a linebacker for the Bears. As a junior, Superman was ranked No. 3 in the nation and gave up just 50 yards a game on the ground.

50 - Worn by **Len Ford**, who would go on to enjoy a brilliant career in the NFL where he was also inducted into the NFL Hall of Fame (1975).

63 - Worn by **Roosevelt Brown**, who played right tackle for Morgan State and would go on to enjoy a brilliant career in the NFL where he was also inducted into the NFL Hall of Fame.

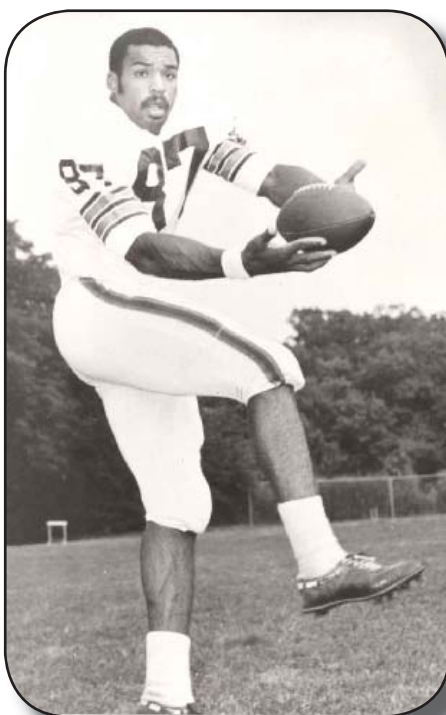
70 - Worn by **Harold Bell**, who was a four-year starter at right tackle. He played in the

71 - John "Tiny" Andrews was an All-American and was drafted by Detroit Lions, however he didn't make the team...so he signed with the World Football League's Birmingham Team.

80 - Worn by **Ronald Mayo**, who was an outstanding receiver for the Bears in the early 70's. In 1970 Mayo had 32 receptions for 526 yards and averaged 16.4 yards per catch...Mayo was also a field goal and kick-off specialist.

81 - Worn by **Jeff Queen**, who played tight end for

84/86 - Worn by **Elvis Franks**, who holds the Morgan State record for most tackles in a career...The 6'5, 265-pounder collected 348 tackles and later played for the Cleveland Browns and Los Angeles Raiders.

87 - Raymond Chester, originally went to the Buffalo Bills then he played for the Oakland Raiders. The Raiders traded him to the Baltimore Colts for NFL Hall of Famer Bubba Smith. **Gregory Latta** also wore #87. Latta was an All-Conference performer at defensive end on the 1970 MSU team, drafted in the 8th round by the Baltimore Colts, but signed with the World Football League's Washington Ambassadors as an 11th round selection.

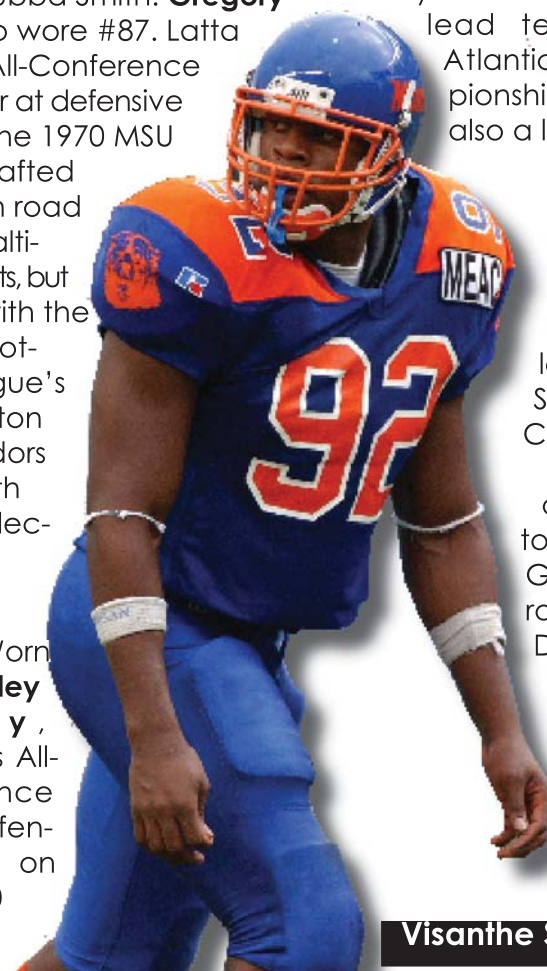
90 - Worn by **Stanley Cherry**, who was All-conference at defensive end on the 1970
